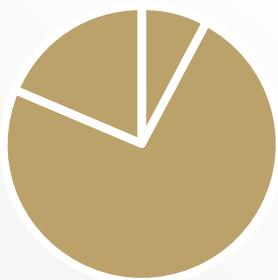


Georgia Tech's 2021 Incoming Class

2021 First-Year Students

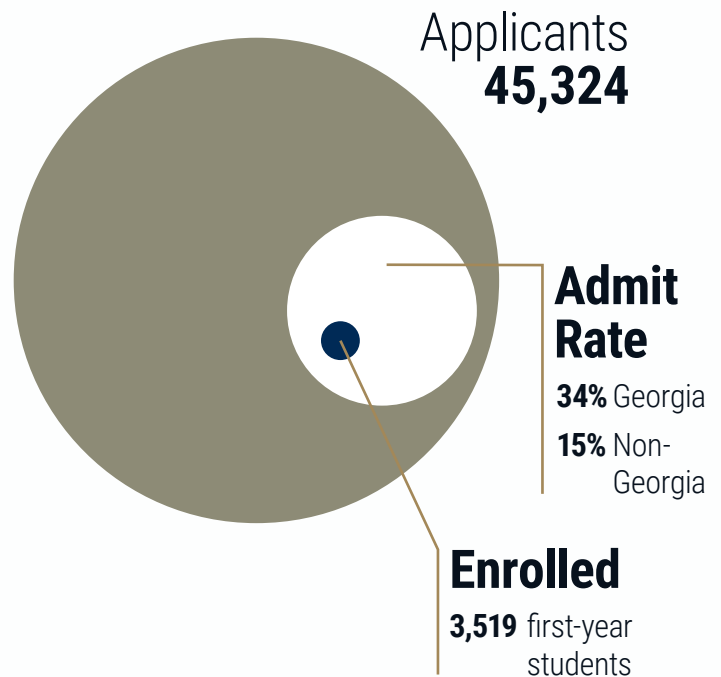
Rank in High School Class*

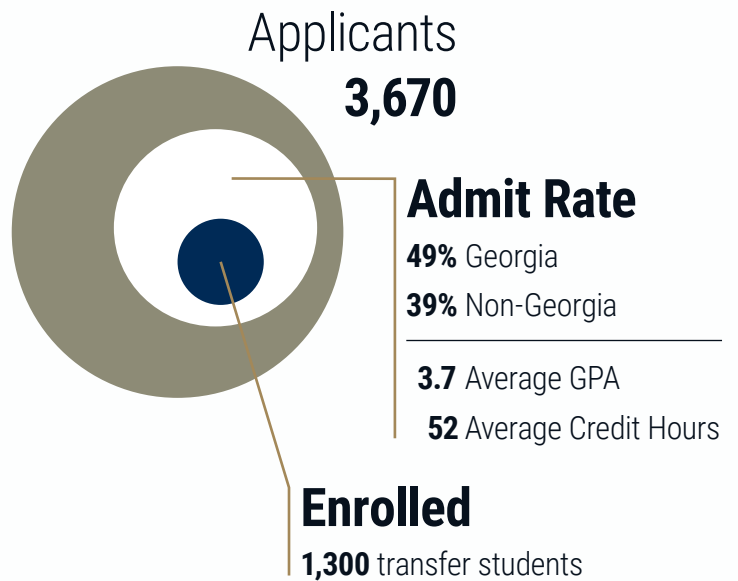
2021 Transfer Students
